MIT Technology Loan

- <\$3,400 No co-signer needed.
- > \$3,400 Credit worthy co-signer required.
- Must be enrolled half time, make academic progress, and not default on prior education loans.
- Minimum monthly payment is \$50 & must be repaid within 10 years.



- No interest until repayment begins, 7% interest afterward.
 - Repayment begins 9 months after graduation or withdrawal, but may be deferred while in graduate or professional school.
